**ENACTING AN ORDINANCE CONDONING THE PENALTY/IES
AND/OR SURCHARGE/S OF THE UNPAID LEASE/RENTALS OF THE
STALLS AT STA. CRUZ PUBLIC MARKET AND LICENSES OF
BUSINESS OPERATORS OF STA. CRUZ**

WHEREAS, there are a number of occupants/lessees of government stalls in the Sta. Cruz Public Market that failed to pay regular their respective rentals;

WHEREAS, the non-payment of rentals has earned for them penalties or surcharges;

WHEREAS, the present economic crisis make it difficult for the stall lessees/occupants to pay the accrued back rentals and penalties or surcharges;

WHEREAS, in order for the municipal government to collect unpaid rentals and help alleviate the plight of the poor small scale businessmen and market vendors from their financial worries, it is a better economic solution that the accrued penalties/surcharge resulting from the non-payment of rentals be condoned;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Jerome A. Undalok, unanimously seconded, it was

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the Sangguniang Bayan of Sta. Cruz, assembled in session to enact the following:

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 07

**CONDONING THE PENALTY/IES AND/OR SURCHARGE/S
OF THE UNPAID LEASE/RENTALS OF THE STALLS
AT STA. CRUZ PUBLIC MARKET AND LICENSES
OF BUSINESS OPERATORS OF STA. CRUZ**

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Sta. Cruz, in session assembled that:

SECTION 1 - There shall be enacted an ordinance which condones the penalty/ies and/or surcharge/s of the unpaid lease/rentals of the stalls at Sta. Cruz Public Market and licenses of business operators of Sta. Cruz.

SECTION 2 - The rental fees, local business taxes and licenses, surcharges, interest and penalties be condoned up to June 30, 2002 provided they will pay their accrued payments/obligations.

SECTION 3 - The first and second quarters be free of penalties/surcharges and the third and fourth, if not paid shall accrue the interest for the period.

SECTION 4 - The said amnesty is valid up to December 31, 2002.

SECTION 5 - Any ordinance inconsistent with this ordinance or with any of its provision is hereby repealed, modified or amended.

SECTION 6 - This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
