**ENACTING AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 2 AND 3 OF
MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 28, SERIES OF 1996 AND OTHER
AMENDMENTS**

WHEREAS, the rental rate of dumptrucks imposed by the municipal government needs to be further amended due to tremendous increase of crude oil and other commodities;

WHEREAS, after a thorough deliberation, the Body decided to amend some provisions of the previous enactment prescribing the rental rate of municipal owned dumptrucks;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Atty. Ignatius R. Bajo, unanimously seconded, it was

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the Sangguniang Bayan of Sta. Cruz, assembled in session to enact an ordinance amending Section 2 and 3 of Municipal Ordinance No. 28, series of 1996 and other amendments,

**AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 28, SERIES OF 1996,
PRESCRIBING RENTAL RATES OF DUMPTRUCKS SPECIFICALLY
SECTIONS 2 AND 3**

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Sta. Cruz, in session assembled that:

SECTION 1 - There shall be amended in Sections 2 and 3 of Municipal Ordinance No. 28, s. 1996;

SECTION 2 - The new rental rate shall be:

P3,000.00/day excluding crude oil and other lubricants and overtime pay of operators

SECTION 3 - There shall be a downpayment of 50% of the total rental fees upon the release of the equipments if it exceeds five (5) days and balance shall be guaranteed by a postdated check which shall be covered by an acknowledgment receipt given a 15-day mandatory settlement period; provided however, if rental does not exceed five (5) days, the total amount shall be paid before the equipment shall be released;

SECTION 4 - A lease contract duly signed by both parties and duly notarized shall form part of the equipment of the lease contract in which case the notarization shall be borne by the lessee;

SECTION 5 - This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
